

Major programs at Hamm Clinic and program accomplishments

Program

Outpatient mental health services for adults that consists primarily of individual therapy, group therapy and couples therapy. Hamm Clinic also provides psychiatric care and psychological testing.

Accomplishments

- Provided care to 772 patients totaling over 10,000 visits
- Welcomed over 260 new clients to Hamm Clinic
- Completely remodeled our client reception area

Program

A client financing program that relies partially on fundraising to support our mission mandate to provide quality care to those who cannot afford the full cost of care.

Accomplishments

- Provided over 1,000 visits to clients with no insurance
- Received our first-ever grant from the Weyerhaeuser Family Foundation

Program

Training mental health professionals which consists of a psychology internship program that is accredited by the American Psychological Association, a social work internship program that supports placements from accredited schools, being a placement site for residents in the Hennepin/Regions internship program, having a fellowship program and providing training opportunities to the wider community.

Accomplishments

- Successfully trained two psychology interns, two social work interns, two psychiatry residents and one fellow
- Presented a conference at St. Catherine University titled Integrating Relational Patterns Into Psychotherapy: The Mother-Child Reunion attended by over 200 professionals
